



Network Newbury Privacy Commitment and Guarantee Policy

We are committed to protecting your personal privacy. Our Eight Principles of Privacy summarize and clarify that commitment: how we safeguard your privacy, how we treat personal information, and what choices you have. We understand that for you to take full advantage of the benefits of this interactive medium, we must do everything we can to ensure that your privacy is secured.

- (1) We do not read your private online communications or documents.
- (2) We do not use any information about where you personally go on Network Newbury or the Web, and we do not give it out to others.
- (3) We do not give out your telephone number, credit card information or screen names, unless you authorize us to do so.
- (4) We do not use information about the kinds of products to make other marketing offers to you. We do not give out this purchase data to others.
- (5) We will not delete recent documents so you can easily see what we have accessed, If in the rare event of accessing personal information is absolutely necessary we will ask your permission first.
- (6) We take extra steps to protect the safety and privacy of our customers especially children.
- (7) We use secure technology, privacy protection controls and restrictions on employee access in order to safeguard your personal information.
- (8) We will keep you informed, clearly and prominently, about what we do with your personal information.

(1) We do not read your private online communications.

Network Newbury honours the confidentiality of its customers private communications, e-mail (including downloads), pictures and documents, as well as any profile data you may create, such as a stock portfolio. Network Newbury does not read or disclose private communications except to comply with valid legal process such as a search warrant, subpoena or court order, to protect the company's rights and property, or during emergencies when we believe physical safety is at risk.

(2) We do not use any information about where you personally go networknewbury.co.uk or the Web, and we never give any details other organisations or person(s)

We do not use any of this navigational data about where you -- as an individual member -- go on our service. Nor do we share any of this data with outside companies.

We do not keep track of where you go on the World Wide Web.

The Web sites you visit may have their own privacy policies or no policy at all. We encourage you to review the privacy policies of Web sites before providing them with any of your personal information.

(3) We do not give out your telephone number, credit card information or screen names.

Network Newbury will not give out your telephone number or screen names (e-mail addresses), except where needed to deliver a product or service you ordered.

We will not give out your credit or debit card number or checking account information.

We will not give out information that would link your screen names with your actual name.

Please note: We do have exceptions to these policies: We will release specific information or details only to comply with valid legal process such as a search warrant, subpoena or court order, or in special cases such as a physical threat to you or others.

(4) We do not use information about the kinds of products to make other marketing offers to you. We do not give out this purchase data to others.

Purchases from Network Newbury



1) We review what kinds of products and services appeal most to our customer as a group. This statistical information helps us improve our offerings in the same way that other companies change their catalogue based on what sells best.

2) We use information such as the number of purchases members make and the categories of goods and services they buy to make offers to them we believe will be of interest.

We also use publicly available consumer data to help us decide which marketing offers to make and which advertising they see.

We do not give out any information about what you, as an individual, purchase from Network Newbury with anyone, except to complete your transactions, or to comply with valid legal process such as a search warrant, subpoena or court order.

(5) We will not delete recent documents so you can easily see what we have accessed, if in the rare event of accessing personal information is absolutely necessary we will ask your permission first.

Any information that is necessary to be accessed will be kept completely private and confidential, and Network Newbury does not remove or delete history of access to private areas.

(6) We take extra steps to protect the safety and privacy of our customers especially children.

Young people need special safeguards and privacy protection. We realize they may not understand all the provisions of our policy or be able to make thoughtful decisions about the choices available to adult members, and we urge all parents to teach their children about protecting their personal information.

No Network Newbury engineer will be left alone in an office, room or home with a child all engineers are instructed to leave immediately and speak to the main contact of the call if in the event they can not be found the engineer is to contact the Network Newbury main office Network Newbury will never collect names, addresses, telephone numbers or other personally identifiable information without disclosing how that information will be used and notifying teens that they should obtain permission from their parents before providing any information.

Network Newbury will not release any information regarding children except to comply with valid legal process (such as search warrant, subpoena, or court order), or in special cases such as threatened harm to a child.

(7) We use secure technology, privacy protection controls and restrictions on employee access in order to safeguard your personal information.

We use state-of-the-art technology to keep your personal information—including your billing and account information—as secure as possible. We also have put in place privacy protection control systems designed to ensure that your personal data remain safe and private.

Each and every Network Newbury employee must abide by Network Newbury's privacy policy. Only authorized Network Newbury employees are permitted to have access to your personal information and such access is limited by need.

All Network Newbury employees are required to acknowledge that they understand and will comply with this privacy policy. Employees who violate our privacy policies are subject to disciplinary action, up to and including termination.

We strongly encourage our content, commerce and advertising partners to post clearly their own privacy policies and to have privacy control systems in place to protect your personal information. Be sure to review their privacy policies and contact them directly if you have any questions.



- (8) We will keep you informed, clearly and prominently, about what we do with your personal information.**

A key part of Network Newbury's commitment to protecting your privacy is ask permission to access your personal information.
